



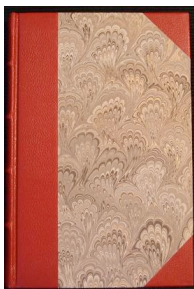

2) The regular hardbound version is priced at \$33 postpaid and may be ordered via the same email address.
